# ethnopoly

**Ethnopoly** is a game that lets you discover the social and cultural diversity of local residents, associations and institutions. Ethnopoly is organised in small teams and encourages dialogue between people from different cultures.

## First edition in Pont-Rouge on Friday 26 September 2025!

#### The teams

The teams are made up of 7th and 8th year primary school pupils from Pont-Rouge school, aged between 10 and 12. In groups of 4 children accompanied by an adult, they tour the neighbourhood and its surroundings to discover the themes presented.

### The posts

Throughout the day (or half-day, around 20 residents, workers, associations and institutions from Lancy welcome the teams into their homes to give them a fifteen-minute presentation on an aspect of their culture, a special feature of the town or an area of expertise.

## How the game works

Using a map, the children choose the places they want to visit. At each stop, they discover a theme: paella recipes, Arabic writing, tea tasting, how to tie a sari, etc., as well as waste sorting at the town hall, the town council and the activities of local associations.

### Aim of the game

To accumulate cultural wealth by meeting the inhabitants of Pont-Rouge and discovering the town. Each team receives points for visiting the stations. To win, a team must meet as many people as possible. The day ends with a snack, a show and a prize-giving ceremony for the three groups that have accumulated the most points.
